Creative Tapestry Weaving

Discover the craft of tapestry weaving on a simple cardboard loom and produce pictorial, patterned and textural works in yarn with teaching artist Fiona Lewis. This workshop is aimed at adults of all artistic levels interested in accessing the art of woven cloth. Basic tapestry techniques will be taught, explored and used to produce patterns and pictures using materials that can be readily resourced. Additional methods of adornment will be applied to add texture and dimension. This workshop will also investigate the practical application of pattern design and weaving, ways of delivering a woven textile project to a class. This will be a practical, hands-on experience in which everybody will begin the production of an original woven textile. Participants are encouraged to bring small found items that they wish to include in their work. **A Professional Development Opportunity for Teachers.**

In the gallery, the BNG will be showcasing Bermuda motor bikes, the contemporary work of Kevin Morris, African Art in Motion; African masks and their function as well as archival and contemporary photographs that tell Bermuda's History.
