

## **BNG After School COVID-19 Guidelines:**

**1. Lateral Flow Testing:** Twice a week lateral flow testing will be required for students to attend our after-school programme. The results must be uploaded every Sunday and Wednesday before midnight into a form we will provide.

While many schools have rolled out twice a week lateral flow testing, we are aware that some students will not be enrolled in a school scheme. Students who are not involved in a regular testing scheme through their school will be provided with lateral flow home test kits. If your child is not part of a school scheme and you require home testing kits, you must indicate this on the registration form.

Students who do not provide test results will not be able to attend our programme that day. **Please understand that lateral flow testing is key to providing a safe environment for all students and staff and allows this programme to proceed.**

**2. Student Arrival Temperature Check:** The after-school programme starts at **3:45 PM**.

Upon arrival all students and staff are required to wear face masks. Each student and staff member will have their temperature checked using a touchless thermometer.

Students arriving by car will be checked prior to exiting the car in case of illness.

Walk-in students and those arriving from public transportation will be temperature checked upon arrival. If they have a temperature greater than 100.4°F (38°C), a BNG staff member will wait with them on the City Hall front porch socially distanced whilst their parent/guardian is contacted and until their parent/guardian arrives.

**3. Good To Go:** Having passed the temperature check, students must proceed into the workspace and wear their mask until leave. All students and staff will sanitise their hands with the provided sanitiser.

**4. Daily Camp Guidelines:** Students will socially distance at all times during daily camp activities. Each student's workspace will be clearly marked out. Each student will be assigned their own equipment. Sharing equipment is not permitted.

Sharing food and water bottles is not permitted.

**5. Moving About:** When a student leaves the BNG, whether it is for a field trip, recess break, or to use the bathroom, they must wear their mask and sanitise their hands upon return, as well as both before and after eating. Bottles of hand sanitiser will be provided for any field trips, as well as for outdoor recess and lunch.

### **Sick Policy:**

Any child or member of staff with a fever equal to or greater than 100.4°F (38°C) must stay home. Staff/children with any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, muscle aches, fatigue, difficulty breathing, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, headache, diarrhoea, vomiting, or sudden loss of smell and taste) should stay home from symptom onset and seek medical attention immediately. When in doubt, parents should consult their child's doctor for guidance.

Parents are **required** to report if student absences are due to any COVID-related symptoms.

**Isolation Room:** If a student or teacher develops COVID symptoms while at camp, they will be monitored in an isolation room while their parent or guardian is called to immediately collect them.

**Covid Case:** If we become aware of a suspected COVID-19 case at camp, or of a case associated with a close contact of someone who has attended camp, camp will be closed for professional deep cleaning. The programme will resume only after approval from the Bermuda Government Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.

**Cleaning & Sanitising Schedule –** A staff member is required to wipe down all “hotspot” areas with approved cleaning supplies daily. At the end of each week, all equipment and materials will be wiped down in preparation for the next week. Additional deep cleaning will be commissioned by an external service provider as required.

Only approved cleaning supplies are to be used for scheduled cleaning.
